

| <b>Yellow Fever</b>              | Recommended for people traveling to places where yellow fever vaccine is compulsory e.g. Angola, Burundi, Cameroon, French Guiana, Gabon, Ghana etc.                                 | <b>\$250</b>                 | <b>\$295</b>           |
| <b>Typhoid Fever</b>             | Recommended for people traveling to places where typhoid fever is common, such as South Asia, especially India, Pakistan, or Bangladesh.   | <b>\$44</b>                  | <b>\$89</b>            |
| <b>Meningococcal Vaccination</b> | For travel to parts of Africa and Saudi Arabia to immunise against meningococcal disease, meningitis and bloodstream infections. Required vaccination for Hajj or Umrah pilgrimages. | <b>\$90</b>                  | <b>\$135</b>           |

# Important information

Onsite, in-clinic and home-based vaccinations

## Before Vaccination



You will receive an email, with a link to sign up for the vaccination and to download the DA app.



Complete the registration form to sign-up for your appointment.



Once submitted you will receive an acknowledgement email.

For home-based vaccination, an additional confirmation email as well as a reminder one day prior to vaccination will be sent.



On the day of your appointment, please arrive/be ready at the specified location a few minutes prior to your appointment time.


## During Vaccination




Registration and DA app download (if yet to). If you've opted for additional vaccines, payment will be collected during registration.



Complete a short health declaration form.



Please inform DA nurses if you have any drug or food allergies prior vaccination.

## How to prepare



Please present the necessary documents (identification card, passport, staff pass) for verification upon registration.



Wear loose or short sleeves that can be rolled up easily, so that health workers have easy access to your arm.

# FAQ

## **Q. Can I choose my preferred appointment time?**

Yes, you may select your preferred slot time from the appointment timings available during registration.

## **Q. Can I do a vaccination after recovering from Covid-19?**

Yes, however we recommend that you speak with a doctor to make sure that you are ready to do a vaccination after recovering from Covid-19.

## **Q. Can I change my appointment date after making a booking?**

You can change the date and time of your vaccination up to 5 days before your appointment.

- Home-based: To request the change, please contact the mobile health team at [mobilemed@doctoranywhere.com](mailto:mobilemed@doctoranywhere.com)
- In-clinic: You can reschedule your appointment using the same link you had used to book your initial appointment or directly contact your selected clinic.

## **Q. How can I relieve the discomfort of common side effects such as fever, pain, and swelling that may come after a vaccination?**

If you experience flu-like symptoms, you can take a OTC medication such as paracetamol or ibuprofen. Placing a cold, wet cloth over the injection site will help reduce pain, redness, or swelling.

## **Q. What signs should prompt me to see the doctor after the vaccination?**

Please see a doctor if you experience any of the following:

- When side effects persist for more than a few days.
- A high fever (>38 deg C) or a fever that has persisted for more than 48 hours (2 days) despite taking medication.
- Severe allergic reactions where you experience difficulties in breathing, itchy skin rash, swelling around lips, eyes, and face, weakness, dizziness, or a fast heart rate.
